Year-End Medication Pick up


If your student has over the counter and/or prescription medication in the Aprende Health Office, please make time to pick it up during the last week of school.

JV Aprende Baseball Jaguars With a 10 run first inning, the offense was off to the start they needed. Multiple hits came from Spencer Bigham, Landon Bickford, Tanner Robertson, Evan Dunn and Colton Pruetz. Spencer went 3-4 at the plate with 3 runs and 3 runs batted in. Catcher Jones started on the mount, pitched 2 innings allowing only 1 hit and striking out 3. L.J. Thompson closed the game on the hill pitching the last two innings, allowing only 2 runs. The JV Jaguars brought home the District Championship!

5/2 Varsity Championship Game - **Aprende Jaguars Varsity Baseball** losses a close tough game 6-5 @ Akimel in the 2022 Championship. The Jags came out swinging on Monday and built a 4-0 lead by the middle of the 4th inning. In a huge offensive 3rd inning for the Jags, right-fielder Aidan Gattie got things started with a line-drive single to center. Second-baseman Nash Bigham singled on the next atbat, moving Gattie to third. Next at-bat, pitcher Quinn Atwood hit a sacrifice fly, scoring Gattie and moving Bigham to third. With one out and a runner on, shortstop Parker Williams came up to the plate and blasted a line-drive double to left, scoring Bigham. In the next at-bat Centerfielder Hugo Chamberlain reached base on an error, and after first-baseman Caden Correll walked, the Jags had the bases loaded. Left-fielder Cam Kennedy hit a ground ball and reached base on an error by the Akimel pitcher, scoring Williams and giving Aprende a 4-0 lead at the end of the 3rd. Things were still looking good for the Jags in the bottom of the 4th inning. After a great double-play by Parker Williams and Nash Bigham the Jags had Akimel at two outs and two runners on, but unfortunately the game began to unravel. Akimel scored on a throwing error and then walks and passed balls began mounting for Aprende's pitchers. After two Aprende pitching changes, Akimel had a 6-4 lead by the end of the 4th. The usually steady Jaguar pitchers walked a total of 9 batters in the game. The Jags rallied a couple of times, but it just wasn't enough to overcome Akimel's closer. Aprende out-hit Akimel 7-3 and Caden Correll led the Jags with 2 hits. Quinn Atwood started on the mound for Aprende. The hurler finished with 3.2 innings, allowing 3 hits, 3 runs, and striking out 4. Parker Williams and Austin Pierce pitched in relief, throwing 1.1 innings and allowing no hits, 3 runs and striking out 1. Regardless of the outcome, Aprende's Varsity team had THE BEST pitching staff in the district this season! In addition, 14 players on the team pitched this year. This was a special team of 16 (largest in the district) who put together a truly great and memorable season! We finished 2022 in 2nd place with an overall record of 8-4-1.
