Meet the Teacher

Meet the Teacher Information July 25, 2022; 5:00pm-6:45pm

Unlike last year we are not dividing the evening into two sessions based on last name.

During Meet the Teacher families and students will follow their daily schedule. This event is NOT an open house. It is important the schedule is followed in order to limit the number of individuals in any one area at a time. Teachers will be providing presentations during each class period/session.

The MPR will open at 4:30 (for PTSO apparel sales) and classroom buildings will open at 4:45 PM, with the first session beginning at 5:00 PM. During the lunch period on the schedule (3rd for 6th; 4th for 7th; 5th for 8th), families are invited to the MPR to see the cafeteria and pick up any informational materials (athletics, food services, PTSO, etc.). The school bells will signal for families to transition to the next class for another curriculum presentation and to meet the next teacher.

We are encouraging students and parents to access schedules in advance through StudentVue and/or ParentVue. Student schedules will be available on Monday, July 25th around 2:00 PM. In an effort to save paper and reduce crowding, we will not be passing out paper copies of student schedules. Please

consider adding the ParentVUE mobile app to your phone for easy access. If for some reason you cannot access your child's schedule through <u>ParentVUE</u> or StudentVUE please contact the front office at 480-541-6200.

Schedule changes will only be considered in cases where a student is scheduled into a class that is an incorrect level or because of a missing class. We will have schedule correction forms available for parents to submit if this is the case. We will not be making any elective changes.

ParentVue Mobile App

The ParentVUE Mobile application helps parents stay informed and connected by providing day-to-day insight into their child's academic experience. ParentVUE Mobile for the iPhone/iPod Touch works with the Synergy™ student information system in much the same way as the ParentVUE web portal, allowing parents to access near real-time information on assignments and scores, attendance, and demographic information. ParentVUE offers parents a single sign-on to view all of their children's information regardless of school.


Logging in to ParentVUE Mobile App

After downloading the ParentVUE Mobile App from the App store, follow these directions to log in.


 When opening the app for the first time, you will be asked to connect to your school district. Swipe left to search.

<u>Schedules/Schedule Changes</u>-Schedules will be available in <u>ParentVUE</u> by 2pm on July 25th. Please print or copy the schedule for Meet the Teacher/the first day of school. We will not be providing paper copies on those days. When logging in to your account, the schedule can be obtained by clicking the

schedule icon on the left-hand side. Please note that no schedule changes will be made (electives, teacher change, etc.) unless an error in the schedule occurs or a student is missing a class.

<u>First Day of School/Bell Schedule</u>-Students may arrive on campus no earlier than 7:50. The first bell rings at 8:15. Dismissal is at 3:05 and students must be picked up no later than 3:15. A detailed bell schedule can be found <u>here</u>.

<u>PE Uniforms</u>- Can now be purchased through Kyrene's online payment portal. Kyrene School District has a convenient payment portal for parents to pay for everything from athletics to field trips. The <u>InTouch payment portal</u> will provide parents with digital receipts for all of your transactions. You can even use it to make this year's tax credit donation to the school of your choice. Register once and use the portal all year. (At this time, payments for Preschool, Kids Club and After Hours will still be made through Community Education.)

<u>School Breakfast and Lunches</u>- As a reminder, the federal government is no longer providing universal free school breakfast and lunch meals. The universal access to free meals decreased the importance of and need for families to complete the application for free or reduced price meal eligibility. Beginning in the 2022-2023 school year, Kyrene will be returning to the pre-COVID meal service model of offering free, reduced price and paid breakfast and lunch. In order to determine if your student qualifies for free or reduced price meals, we ask that all families complete the free and reduced meal application located at family.titank12.com. Additionally, Kyrene meal prices will remain the same as the 2021-2022 school year. When we return to school on July 28th students will be required to pay for their meals (unless they receive a free lunch), Al-a carte items, or additional drinks.

Meal payments can be made on the <u>InTouch Payment Portal</u> this year. Parents can view meal balances or pay by check/cash at schools. Free & Reduced lunch applications are available at school sites (and will be available during Meet the Teacher Night), or online above. 
<u>Transportation</u>- Families can access information regarding Bus Routes and Bus Safety by visiting the Kyrene webpage and looking under the Parent Tab or by selecting the following <u>link</u>.

Below is a map showing some of the signs that the City of Chandler has installed in our school zone. There are also "Do Not Enter Signs" on the Exits to each of our parking lot driveways. Please do not use the North Staff Parking Lot during drop off and pick up times. This parking lot is for staff and buses only during those times. Please review the map - it shows where to drop off and pick up depending on the direction you enter our school zone. Also, there should be no dropping your student off when you are stopped in middle of the road. This is a huge safety concern. We also prefer that you utilize the drop off system instead of parking on the street or at Desert Breeze Park to drop your child off at school as this causes more traffic issues and interrupts the way the flow of traffic is supposed to work.

If you travel from Ray Road you will turn left into the large parking lot in front of Aprende to drop off & pick up, exit right back towards Ray Road. Once you pull into the parking lot and come to a stopping point in the drop off line, your child should immediately exit the vehicle onto the sidewalk and enter the school. This allows you to be ready to move and exit the parking lot when the line moves again. Please stay in the drop off line and wait for the line to move to exit.

If you travel from McClintock you will turn right into the parking lot in front of Brisas, pull all the way forward, and your child will exit onto the sidewalk and walk in front of Brisas to Aprende. You will exit this parking lot by turning left and return in the direction of McClintock. Thank you.

Also, for the safety of everyone, we need every student and parent that walks across Desert Breeze Blvd to use one of our cross walks. We have a cross walk at the stop sign at Desert Breeze Blvd and Joshua and another cross walk in front of the Brisas parking lot. We ask that everyone do their part keeping the students safe as they make their way to and from school. No Jaywalking or U-Turns Allowed! Thank you for putting safety first!



Students Are Not Allowed on Campus Until 7:50 AM

Please note, in accordance with the <u>Kyrene Family Handbook</u> and also to promote safe practices, students will not be allowed on campus until 30 minutes prior to the first bell (7:50 a.m.) and must leave immediately at the end of the school day. We do not have adults on school grounds to supervise students prior to 7:50 a.m. and after 3:05 p.m. If you need before or after care/supervision for your student, please call our Kyrene Customer Service Dept. at 480-541-1500.

2022-2023 SCHOOL HEALTH OFFICE MEDICATION POLICY

The Aprende Health Office does NOT stock ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin) Benadryl, Hydrocortisone cream or ointment, Antibiotic ointment or cough drops. However, if your student requires over the counter medication for orthodonture work or menstrual cramps please click here for the Kyrene District policy.

Over-the-counter and prescription medications:


Any medication must be brought into the school health office by an adult and the proper paperwork must be completely filled out. Students are NOT allowed to carry medication on their person at any time, this includes any prescriptions and over the counter meds like Tylenol, Ibuprofen, or cough drops.

Prescription medication must be in its original container and labeled with a current prescription label. All over-the-counter medications (including cough drops) must be in their original factory sealed container with all warnings and directions intact. If you have any questions, please call the health office at 480-541-6220.

ATTENTION ALL NEW APRENDE STUDENT & PARENTS-IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

All newly enrolled 6th, 7th & 8th grade students are required to provide a record of their 11-year-old immunizations, including Tdap and Meningococcal vaccines to the Aprende Health Office. Please check ParentVUE to make sure your student's health records are up to date.

The National Junior Honor Society chapter of Aprende Middle School is a duly chartered and affiliated chapter of this prestigious national organization. Membership is open to those students who meet the required standards in five areas of evaluation: scholarship, leadership, service, citizenship, and character. Standards for selection are established by the national office of NJHS and have been revised

to meet our local chapter needs. Students are selected to be members by a 5-member Faculty Council, appointed by the principal, which bestows this honor upon qualified students on behalf of the faculty of our school each year.

Students currently in grades seven or eight are eligible for membership. For the scholarship criterion, a student must have a **cumulative** GPA of 3.8 or better on a 4.0 scale after **3 consecutive quarters** at the same school. **On August 1, 2022**, those students who meet this criterion are invited by Kyrene email to join the NJHS Candidate Class in Google Classroom in order to complete the Candidate Information Form. This required Form will provide the Faculty Council with information regarding the candidate's leadership and service. A history of leadership experiences and participation in school or community service is also required. The 2022 - 23 Faculty Council uses the following standards to determine a candidate's membership into NJHS:

A completed Candidate Information Form that has at least **two** of the **four** sections filled in thoughtfully. The candidate demonstrates effort to complete the Form to the best of his/her ability and takes each criterion seriously, even if all four sections could not be fully completed. Taking this into consideration, the Faculty Council sees fit that proving more than just Scholarship will meet the criteria for this organization. Please be aware that **elementary school opportunities will not be considered** as examples of a student's **current** leadership, service, or honors/awards.

A completed letter of intent that demonstrates to the best of the candidate's ability that he/she will fulfill the obligations and requirements of membership in NJHS. The letter may not be longer than two pages as stated on the Candidate Information Form.

To help evaluate a candidate's character, the Faculty Council first reviews school disciplinary records. Second, the Candidate Information Forms and personal letters are carefully reviewed by the Faculty Council to determine membership. A majority vote of the Council is necessary for selection. Candidates are notified regarding selection or non-selection according to a predetermined schedule found on the Aprende Middle School master calendar. Following notification, a formal induction ceremony is held at the school to recognize all the newly selected members. Information about NJHS and the selection process may be found on the 2022 NJHS Candidate Google Classroom page. Once inducted, new members are required to maintain the same level of performance (or better) in all five criteria that led to their selection. This obligation includes regular attendance at chapter meetings and events held throughout during the school year and participation in the chapter service projects. Hours of individual service during the school year must be documented and submitted each year of membership, as well. Students or parents who have questions regarding the selection process or
