Reading

Skills-

*Blending sounds to read nonsense words
*Rhyme Recognition-I will be testing on producing rhymes next week. Please practice this with your child.

*We have been working on word families, our blends, and reading lots of books!!

*Practiced writing the upper and lower case Qq.

*We continue to work on all our HFW's . we focused on the words little & one.

***Decodable Books: We practiced reading Little Cat, Big Cat, The Lost Dog, & The Ice Fair Unit-Colonial Towns & Townspeople**

***Rd The Little Gray Pony, The Elves and the Shoemaker and Stone Soup. Ask your child to retell the story and tell you who the characters were in the story.**

***Described and talked about a Weaver, Spinner, Tailor, Dressmaker, Cobbler, Bricklayer, Stonemason, Carpenter and a Blacksmith.**

Math

***We continue to do both adding and subtraction story problems (with missing #'s)**

5+ __=8

***How Many to 10? (Roll a die, then count on to find how many you need to get to 10) You can use a number card too! This week we played**

***We practiced counting by 1's, 5's, and 10's to 100.**

***We counted backwards from 20**

***We practiced counting by 2's to 20 (and higher)**

The children continue to play math games that are going to reinforce the skills we are working on in math.
