ParentVue, Gradebook, and YOU

2019-2020 School year started off a little differently in that parents were asked to “re-enroll” their students. In order to complete this process, parents needed to access online registration through a ParentVue account. Some parents already have access to ParentVue. If you, as a parent, do not have an activated ParentVue account, you may be missing out on a helpful resource.

Through ParentVue, parents and guardians with custodial and educational rights can view their child’s attendance, school schedule, health immunization data and personal profile. Parents of all third-5th grade students can also view their child’s current assignments and grades.

i-Ready is a Math program that provides an online personalized learning pathway for students based on their Diagnostic results. Families have the ability to access the math resource to view online lessons, student progress, math tools, the student math book and learning games.

How to Access i-Ready from home:

From the Kyrene Homepage, click on **Students** and select the **Educational Resources** link.

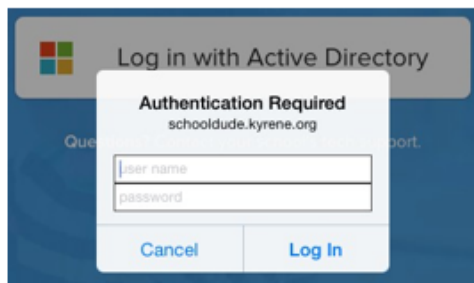
1. Click on the i-Ready button to launch i-Ready sign-in page.



2. Click **Log in with Active Directory**. Since this is done at home, students will be required to log in with their Kyrene network user name and password.

3. **These fields may appear and function differently, depending on the browser used at home.** Enter the student's username and password in the fields.

***NOTE:** If entering the username and password does not work, then enter it in this form:
ksd\student# followed by the student's password.



4. Click **Log In**.

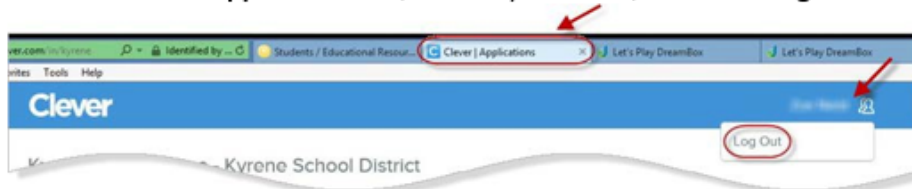
5. Click on the i-Ready button.



6. Begin using i-Ready.

When you are finished:

1. Exit i-Ready. *If on an iPad, swipe up to close the i-Ready app after every session.*
2. Select the **Clever Applications** tab, click on your name, and select **Log Out**.

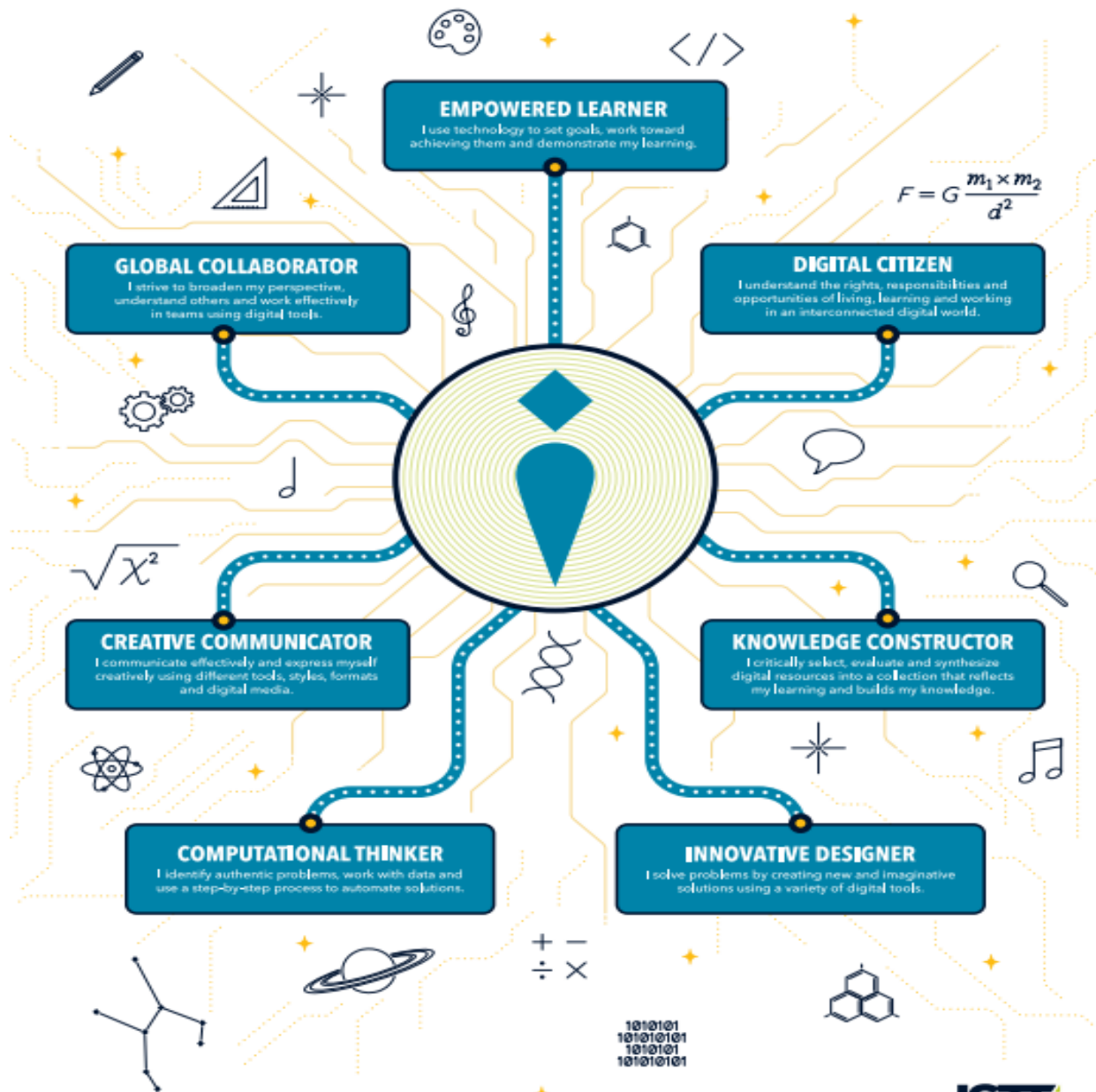


A word from Mariposa's Computer Science /Gifted Resource Teacher, Megan Ting:
