Parker Williams drives in 5 as the Varsity Jaguars defeat Centennial 14-1. Williams was an RBI machine on Monday, driving in 5 runs on 2 hits to lead the Aprende Varsity Baseball team. The Varsity Jags secured the win thanks to a big 8-run 2nd inning. Hunter Albert, Hugo Chamberlain, Parker Williams and Micah Capps all sent runners across the plate with RBI's in the 2nd. Aprende pitcher Hunter Albert pitched a gem and was the unsung hero of the game. The hurler threw a complete game... Going 4 innings while only allowing 3 hits, striking out 6 batters, and walking zero. The Jaguars defeat Centennial 10-5 at home on Wednesday. Aprende starting pitcher Marcus O'Bleness pitched a great game, leading the Jags to victory. The lefty surrendered 3 runs on 3 hits over 2 innings, while striking out 1. Reporting Your Child's Absence

Aprende Middle School is equipped with a computerized telephone attendance reporting system. The absence/late reporting phone number is 480-541-6201 and may be called 24 hours a day. When calling: please say your name, student's full name, their grade, the date(s) of absence, and a detailed reason for absence along with your phone number.

Parents/legal guardians are asked to call the attendance office by 9:00 a.m. each day that their child is absent or late. If we do not receive a parent phone call, the student's absence will be recorded as Unexcused/Truant.

Signing Students Out Prior to the End of the School Day

For the safety and protection of your child, we cannot allow him or her to be taken from the classroom before our regular dismissal time without the parent/guardian first coming to the office and signing the child out. EACH CHILD WHO IS EXCUSED EARLY MUST BE SIGNED OUT IN THE OFFICE by the child's parent/guardian or by the person(s) specifically authorized by the parents/guardians in their Emergency Contacts.

When signing students out, please print the student's full legal name and if hyphenated we need their entire name. Please refrain from using nicknames as it makes it hard for us to locate them in our student system.

The school office staff WILL NOT RELEASE YOUR CHILD TO ANYONE UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED (must be 18 years or older) by you on the Health Services Emergency Information Card. Please update any changes in your emergency card when they occur.

NOTE: Persons listed on your child's emergency card will be able to sign your child out of school without a note or phone call from you.

In all cases, proper identification must be shown before we can release a child to a parent, guardian, or other authorized person.

It is helpful if you send your child to school with a note indicating the reason for early release and the time which you will pick up your child. The student should give the note to the office first thing in the morning at which time he/she will be given a pass to leave class and come to the office at the appropriate time.




