Reading

Skills-We continued these skills along with reading books!

*Phoneme blending-Say a word, can your child tell you each sound in that word?

*Phoneme Segmentation-Can your child identify the number of sounds in a word?

*Rhyme Recognition-We continued to work on producing rhymes.

*Listen for initial sound of /k/ & /o/.

*Practiced writing the upper and lower case Kk & Oo.

*Decodable Books: We practiced reading *The Big Ram* & *What can Hop?*

*We read *A Snowy Day* & *The Disappearing Snowman*

Unit on Kings & Queens

*Read *Sing a Song of Sixpence*, *The Princess and the Pea*, *Cinderella*, and *Snow White*. We focused on characters, setting, plot, and recalling facts.

Social Studies

We started practicing our poems & songs for the Patriotic Program. We will start learning about Presidents and Symbols next week. ☺

Math

*How Many to Ten-The children found different combinations that add up to 7 & 8. Have them tell you the different ways.

*100th Day of School-We counted to 100, played a Race to 100 game, where we identified the number that we landed on, we found the missing numbers on the 100th chart.

*We practiced writing equations. (4+4=8)

Computer Lab

The children used their drawing tool, text tool, sticker tool, & their fill in tool to create their All About Me page. They will be working on different pages to create, so that they can make a slide show for you to view during conferences.

Author Study

We have been reading books by Jan Brett. Go to the Ironwood Library and check out some of her books and some fairy tale books. You can ask your child to retell the story using these types of books
