BACK TO SCHOOL UPDATES

Meet the Teacher Night:

Join us for Meet the Teacher Night on Tuesday, July 27! This is a chance to spend time in your classroom, fill out important forms for your teacher, purchase spirit wear, learn about transportation, set up a lunch account online, and learn more about our PTO. Please enter through the playground gates and walk down to the Cafeteria/Multi-Purpose Room. Maps and school staff will be available to help you find your classrooms.

Teacher assignments will be available on ParentVUE on July 27, 2021.

First Day of School Procedures:

Our first day of school is July 29, 2021. The campus will be open for students at 7:05 am and class will begin at 7:25 am. Students will enter the campus by the playground at 7:05 am and the playground will remain open until 7:15 am. At 7:15 am the bell will ring and students will enter the building through the designated doors. Breakfast will be provided free of charge each day and will be grab and go from carts in the main hallway. Students will proceed to their classrooms to unpack and eat their breakfast. If a student arrives on campus after 7:15 am, they will enter the CA doors, pick up their

breakfast and proceed to their classroom. The last bell will ring, and students should be in class ready to learn at 7:25 am.

In order to minimize the number of people on campus, parents will <u>not</u> be able to visit the classrooms with their students on the first day of school like we traditionally do. You are welcome to take pictures out front and then walk your student to the gate or CA door.

School bus riders will be dropped off at the front of the school and will enter the playground gate or the CA door depending on the time of their arrival.

First Day of School Procedures (KINDERGRATEN ONLY):

To assist our newest learners, we are asking that they be dropped off at the CA door starting at 7:05 am on the first day of school. There will be staff and student helpers available to help them find their classrooms. Teachers will show them the playground and where to go normally in the morning during the first day so they can learn where to go starting Friday morning. We will also be delivering breakfast to the classroom, so students do not have to worry about getting them from the carts. Teachers will also review this with them on the first day as well.

Late Arrival Procedures:

In the event your child arrives on campus after 7:25 am, parents/guardians will need to bring them into the front office and sign them in. Once they have been signed in, they will be given a late pass and proceed through the office to their classroom.

School Supplies:

If you purchased a school supply kit from the PTO in the Spring, your child's kit will be delivered directly to his/her classroom teacher and will be ready for the first day of school. If you are did not purchase a kit in the Spring and will be purchasing supplies from local retailers, please use the <u>supply list</u> on the Cerritos Website. You are welcome to get any brand of supplies from local retailers. Feel free to bring your child's supplies with you to Meet the Teacher Night so you do not have to bring them on the first day of school.

Crosswalk Updates:

Due to a current staffing limitations, we will not have a crossing guard available to assist Cerritos students in crossing the upper crosswalk across from Altadena. Students who need to cross over from the east side of Desert Foothills parkway should walk down the sidewalk to the supervised crosswalk across from Cerritos so they can safely cross to school. If we are able to hire additional staff later this year, we will revisit the use of the upper crosswalk.
