Message from the Principal

Dear Cerritos Families,

The 2021-2022 school year is off to a wonderful start. We are so happy to have everyone back and to welcome new families to Cerritos. Children's voices and laughter have brought our school back to life and we are thrilled to be able to experience learning in person with our students.

At Cerritos we focus on Beginning with the End in Mind in Habit 2. This year our focus is data driven intervention for every student. Our teachers are utilizing beginning of the year data for English language arts and mathematics to monitor where students are starting and how we can best support learning. Teachers will formulate small groups or individual intervention practices that will focus on gaps in specific skill sets.

Our Cerritos leaders will be focusing on the 7 Habits of Happy Kids during the first weeks of school. Students will be establishing class procedures and reviewing CARES around the building, developing class mission statements, organizing leadership notebooks and learning the language of leadership. Be sure to ask your child about CARES and the 7 Habits so they can share their important work with you.

As we start the year, we will continue to utilize all mitigations strategies to keep our students safe and attending school in person. We encourage all students and staff to wear masks while inside our school building. We are hopeful we will have volunteers back in our school buildings soon and we can't wait to have your help again but for now we are not able to have volunteers in our classrooms with students. We look forward to getting Watch Dogs, classroom volunteers and makerspace buddies going again and to introduce some new opportunities in our STEM programs.
