
The weeks are going by fast! We have been so busy in class.

<u>Math</u>

- *We continue to do both adding and subtraction story problems
- *How Many to 10? (Roll a die, then count on to find how many you need to get to 10) You can use a number card too! Check to see how fast your child can give you the answer.
- *We played counters in a cup which helps with adding two numbers to make 10.
- *We had our math coach, Mrs. Green, come and visit us and do story problems. Brett had 12 balloons, Max had 5 balloons, how many more balloons does Brett have than Max? ETC. *How many are we? We counted eyes, ears, noses,
- etc. to find out how many we have in the room.
 *We practiced writing our numbers 10-20.
- Congrats to Madison, Makenzi & Jinan for counting to 100!

Author Study
