5th Grade Students

Are you ready for 6th grade? Are your child's shots up to date? AZ Administration Code requires certain immunizations for school entry/attendance. Please note the immunization requirements listed below:

- Students 11 years of age and older are required to have one dose of Tdap vaccine if 5 years have passed since their last dose of tetanus/diphtheria containing vaccine. Most children had their last DPT when they were 5 years old, so most 11-year-old children will be due for a booster.
- Students 11 years of age and older are required to have one dose of Meningococcal vaccine (MV, MCV4, or Menactra).
- These immunizations will be due by the first day of school, July 29th, 2021, if your student will be 11 years old by that date.

Please review your child's immunizations with your health care provider. When your child receives the necessary immunizations bring the record in to school. The record must show the child's name, date of birth, the month, day and year that the shot(s) were given and the name of the clinic or physician that administered the vaccine. If you have already provided this to your school disregard this notice.
