Reading

Skills-

*Worked on the following HFW's come & what. *Decodable Books: We practiced reading A Big, Big Van, Come In, Hop On Top, What Is in the Box?, & Hop In.

Unit on Columbus and the Pilgrims

*Explained why Europeans wanted to travel to Asia.

*Identified King Ferdinand and Queen Iasabella of Spain.

*Discussed Columbus' 1st voyage.
