## Next week is Spirit Week!

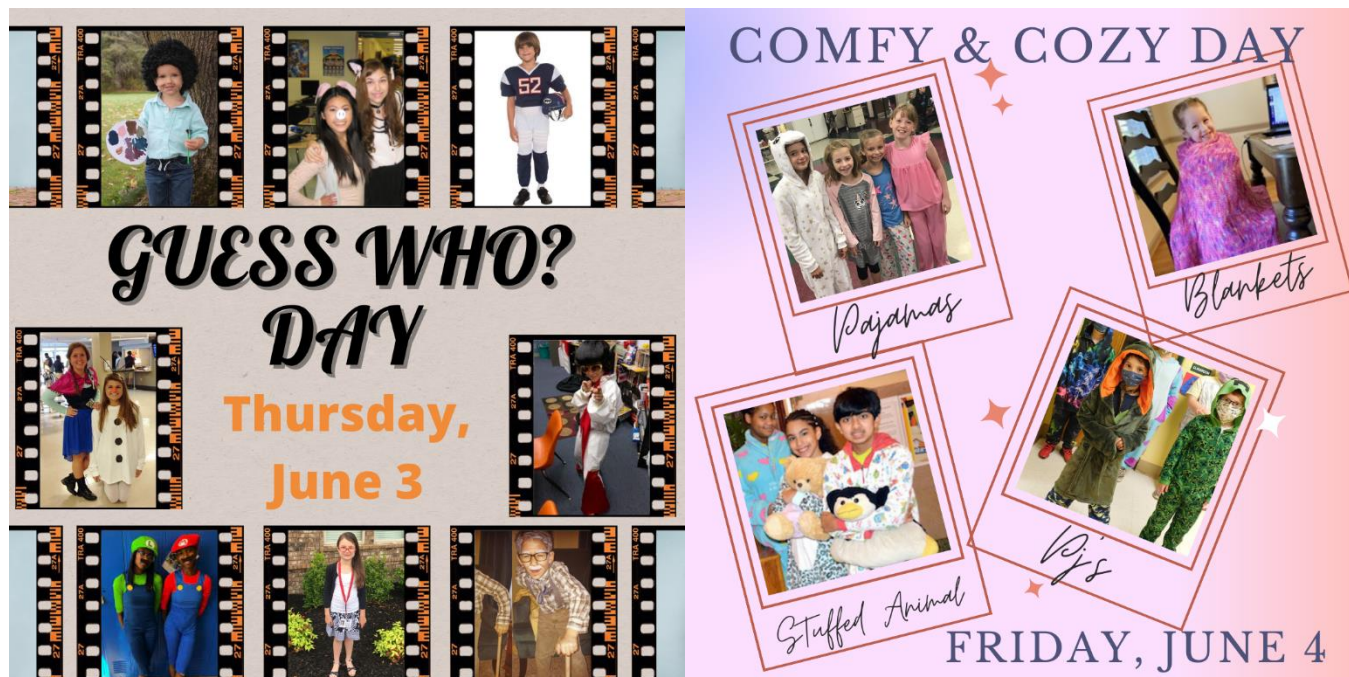
