What We're Learning...

Language Arts

In reading, we will continue our new Human Body unit and learn about our digestive system, circulatory system, nervous system, germs and how to keep from getting sick, and 5 ways to have a healthy, happy lifestyle.

Math

In math, we will be working on recognizing that numbers in an addition sentence can be switched around and still have the same sum (2+3=5 and 3+2=5). We will also be working on strategies to find missing addends $(2+_=5)$.

Writing

In writing, we will continue our writing unit on personal narratives with two or more sequenced events, details, and a closure. We will be editing our work and making sure that our writing contains necessary details.

Science/ Social Studies

In science, we will be doing fun crafts that correlate with our reading unit on the human body. We will do a digestion experiment, create a circulatory system diagram, do an experiment to understand how easily germs are spread, and make a key set to remind us how to stay healthy
