## What We're Learning...

### Language Arts

In reading, we will continue our Human Body unit and learn about a balanced, healthy diet and review the functions of all of our body systems. We will have our Human Body vocabulary review on Thursday and the test on Friday.

#### Math

In math, we will be continuing to learn how to solve for missing addends in an equation (for example, 3 + \_\_\_ = 5). We will also work on fluently adding and subtracting numbers within 10.

#### Science

In science, the students will color, cut, and sort pictures of food into either the "healthy" category or the "unhealthy" category. They will also put together a body systems book with facts to share with you at home.

#### Writing

In writing, we will continue our writing unit on personal narratives with two or more sequenced events, details, and a closure. We will be editing our work and making sure that our writing contains necessary details and complete sentences.
