Skills-

- *Track syllables in a word-How many word parts does a word have?
- *Listened for beg. sounds in words
- * *Phoneme Isolation-We listened for the sound of /c/ & /n/.
- *We brainstormed words that begin with /c/ & /n/.
- *Onset & Rime Blending-Say beg. sound, then the rest of the word part. What word is it?
- * *Pre-decodable Books: We practiced reading The Mat & We Go.
- *High Frequency Words Learned: go
- *We worked on the following word families: am & at. Put a letter at the beginning, what does it say? S-am = Sam
- *In our Unit called **Stories** we identified the characters, finding the beg., middle, and end of the story. (Plot) and retold the events. Identified fiction and folktale stories. We reviewed our stories, discussed what each character wanted in the story, and which story was our favorite and why. Ask your child to tell you which stories we read so far and which one is his/her favorite.
- (I did lots of testing!) Excited to share it with you!


Laptops & IPad
