Skills-

*Phoneme Isolation-Listen to the middle sound in a word

*Phoneme Isolation-We listened for the sound of /d/.

*Onset & Rime Blending-Say beg. sound, then the rest of the word part. What word is it?

*Syllable Segmentation-How many syllables in a word?

*Phoneme Segmentation-How many sounds in word?

***Pre-decodable Books: We practiced reading I Nap**

***High Frequency Words Learned: we**

***We worked on the following word families: ap. Put a letter at the beginning, what does it say? cap, tap, lap, etc.**

*We finished our Unit on Stories and have now started our Unit on Plants.

*We described what plants need to grow and that different kinds of plants grow in different environments.

*Identified the parts of a plant.

Science

*Planted seeds and talked about what plants needed in order to grow.

Math

*Place Value-How many tens and ones are in a teen number? We used a math rack to work out our problem.

*Story Problems-Students learned two strategies to help them solve an addition problem. (Counting by 1's to get to an answer and counting on from the highest number)

*Introduced how to count by 2's & 10's.
