Week of: October 14, 2014

Here's what we are working on!

Reading: We have so many new letters and sight words to learn in the next two weeks! We will be practicing those frequently. We will also be finding key details in text and putting them in order of beginning, middle, end.

Letters/Sounds: Nn, Dd

HFW (High Frequency Words, Sight Words): and, we, go, in

Word Families: -ap (map, cap, etc.)

Theme: Silly Business

Stories: Warthogs in the Kitchen, The Crayon Box That Talked, I Took my Frog to the Library, Butterfly

<u>Writing:</u> We will participate in Writer's Workshop, practicing sounding out words to tell a story to go with our illustration. We will also share our writing with the class. Students will ask each other questions about their piece.

<u>Math:</u> We will begin learning about measurement. We will use a tower of ten cubes and compare classroom items using the vocabulary of "shorter" and "longer". We will also be playing many games that focus on comparing numbers. We will begin adding numbers, starting by playing "Roll and Record" using two dice.

<u>Science:</u> Magnets – We will explore magnets and learn about how and why they work.

<u>Social Studies:</u> Maps – We will learn about different types of maps, the purpose of maps, and how to read maps and map keys.

<u>Health:</u> We will learn about taking care of your skin, and hair.
