Reading: This week we will be reading some pumpkin stories along with our regular curriculum! Next week we will begin the "Family Ties" theme.

Letters/Sounds: Gg, Ff
HFW (High Frequency Words, Sight Words): is, on, to
Word Families: review -at, -am, -ap
Theme: Silly Business/Family Ties
Stories: The Crayon Box That Talked, The Terrible Tragadabas, Off We Go!, A Birthday Basket for Tia, Let's go Froggy, and many pumpkin stories!

Writing: We will spend both weeks strengthening our Writer's Workshop routines. We will learn how to use an ABC chart to help us when sounding out words. We will also get our writing partners! We will practice reading our piece to them, while they ask questions to strengthen our writing.

Math: We will begin learning about patterns and observing patterns in the real world! We will do measurement using our pumpkins, including putting them in order by size and measuring their height.

Science: Magnets - We will explore magnets and learn about how and why they work.

Social Studies: Maps - We will learn about different types of maps, the purpose of maps, and how to read maps and map keys.

## \$ere's what we have been doing...

The past two weeks have flown by! In math, we've begun measurement, by measuring object in the room. We've learned the importance of lining up object correctly when measuring to have an accurate measure. We also used our names on cube towers to measure names that are longer and shorter than our own. In reading we've begun blending (sounding out) words. Students have been amazed at their progress. We did a check-in to see what students felt they had learned the most this year, and many students said letter sounds or reading words! In Science, we worked with magnets. We learned the words "attract" and "repel". Students enjoyed holding the magnets as they snapped together and pushed away from each other.
