Week of: September 15, 2014

Here's what we are working on!

Reading: We will be reading stories and putting the events in order from the story (sequencing). We will practice referring back to the text to check our answers.

Letters/Sounds: Pp, Cc

HFW (High Frequency Words, Sight Words): like

Word Families: None

Theme: Around the Table

Stories: <u>Peanut butter and Jelly</u>, <u>Bunny Cakes</u>, <u>Look</u>, Listen, Taste, Touch, and Smell, My Hands

<u>Writing:</u> We will continue learning the routines of Writer's Workshop.

Math: We will be expanding our knowledge of base ten to numbers beyond 10 – starting this week with 11! We will also learn about inventory bags. These are bags filled with various items of varying amounts. Students will be counting and recording what is in their inventory bag.

<u>Science:</u> The Five Senses – We will focus on touch and smell through stories and experiments.

<u>Social Studies:</u> We will be learning about empathy and how to help a friend who is upset.

<u>Health:</u> In health we will be connecting the parts of the body used to experience the Five Senses.

Here's what we have been doing...

Last week we got into the basics of the five Senses. We read a story called "My five Senses". We then referred back to the story to create a tree map of the information found in the text. The students had a great time going back, looking through the story, and recording what was discovered about each of the senses. In computer lab we began working in

Dreambox. It is a fantastic math program that uses games to engage the students and get them thinking about numbers that are individualized for each student, allowing them to review and advance at their own pace. It also uses math tools we use in the classroom, so the students can relate their Dreambox lessons to lessons in the classroom. Once the students are comfortable playing at school, I'll send home a form with your child's information so they can begin playing at home, too! There are a few features (like the arcade) that are turned off during the school day!
