Is the Dual Language program the same as a bilingual program?

A Dual Language program is a bilingual program. One of the outcomes of the Dual Language program is the development of academic literacy in English and another language simultaneously.

Are there any requirements to enroll my child in a Dual Language Program?

Students enter the Dual Language program when they are in Kindergarten or when students are starting 1st grade. Students who speak and/or reside in a home where another language other than English is spoken at home are assessed to determine English oral proficiency. Enrollment in the Dual Language program is voluntary.

What are the benefits of having my child participate in a Dual Language program?

Research shows that students increase their cognitive flexibility that results in higher-order thinking, problem-solving abilities, multi-tasking, creativity and focusing skills. Dual Language programs focus on learning content through the target language resulting in bilingual and bi-literate students.
