ENRICHMENT: Instrumental Bingo

SHORT DESCRIPTION:

Try to complete one full row on the Bingo Board included on the next page.

MATERIALS:

Worksheet (attached), pencil, paper, your instrument, method book.

If you don't have your instrument at home, what else can you use to create different sounds? Use your imagination. You can try glasses with different amounts of water, different sized dishes, a piano, or even an otamatone! There's no limit to what you can use.

Instrumental Bingo

Perform a NEW Scale and facetime a friend/family member while playing!	Play your Ab Concert Scale (band) or your C Major Scale (orchestra) in all state pattern in UNDER 15 seconds!	Call a friend in band or orchestra and play something for each other over the phone/facetime	Play a book line standing on ONE LEG! (except tubas, who can use opposite hand on the valves 😊)	Perform a “concert” of at least 4 book lines for at least 4 stuffed animals (take a pic and send to us!)
Facetime a friend and try to learn a new book line together – give each other feedback!	Learn a NEW NOTE and play it for 12 seconds!	Research 3 interesting facts about your instrument	Play a song in your book as SOFTLY as you can possible play!	Watch an episode of your favorite TV show, and practice any articulation during all commercials
Clean your instrument REALLY well after a practice session	Before lunch, play as many scales as you can MEMORIZED	Free  Space	Research the history of your instrument (who invented it, how did it look different, etc.)	Record yourself playing a full band or orchestra piece
Play your Bb Concert Scale (band) or D Major Scale (orchestra) while laying on the ground	Find a YouTube video of someone playing your instrument (video must have at least 5,000 views)	Play your favorite beginning song as LOUD as you possibly can!	Figure out and then record yourself playing the beginning of Jurassic Park and send it to a friend for feedback	Memorize one of your book lines and play it in your bathroom
Go outside and practice – see how many people compliment your playing!	Learn the first 6 measures of Harry Potter on your own	Play your Concert F Scale in WHOLE NOTES after lunch	Play a “Concert” of at least 4 book lines for family members after dinner	Write an email to us addressed to an incoming 6 th grader and tell them why they should join band
