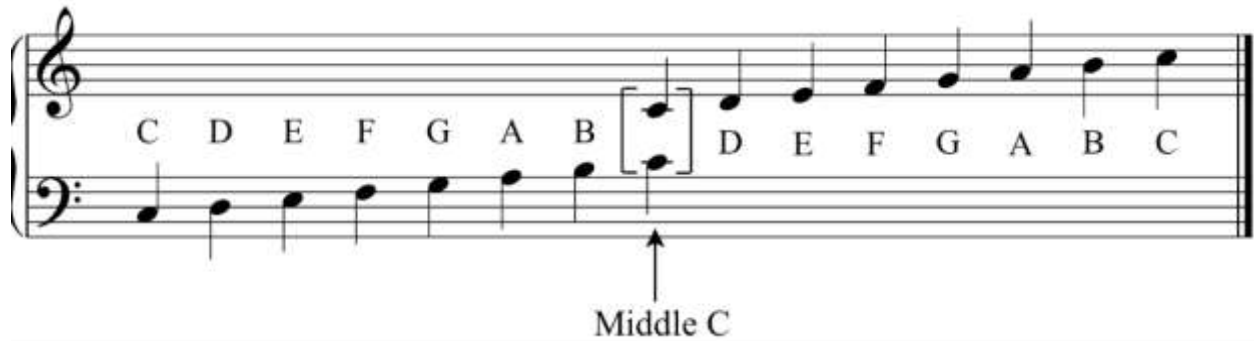


Kyrene Instrumental Ensemble Enrichment for Middle School At-Home Learning

SHORT DESCRIPTION: Learn to write music notation by hand correctly.



MATERIALS:

Worksheet (attached), pen/pencil

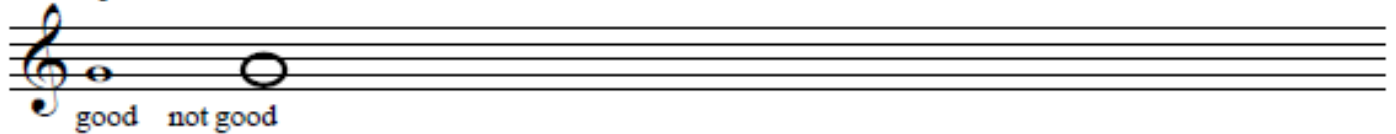
1. Draw 10 barlines neatly, the line should be straight and touch the top and bottom line but not go past them



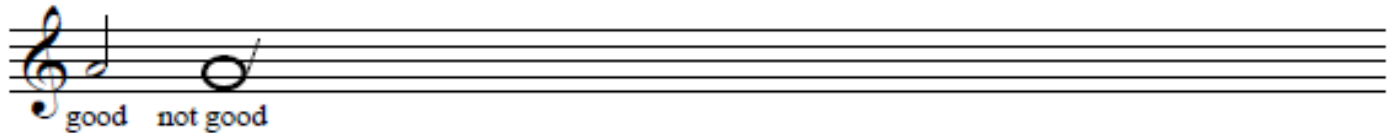
2. Draw 10 whole notes on the bottom space, it should be an oval, as tall as the space, not larger or smaller



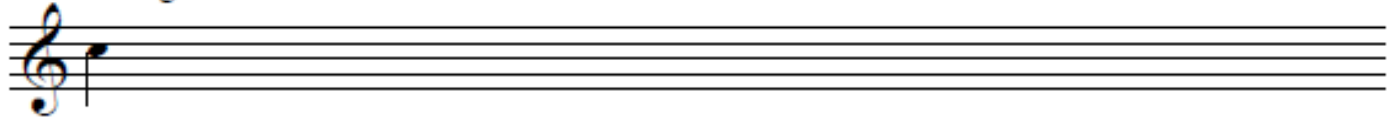
3. Draw 10 whole notes on the second line, the oval should be centered around the line and go halfway into the space above and below



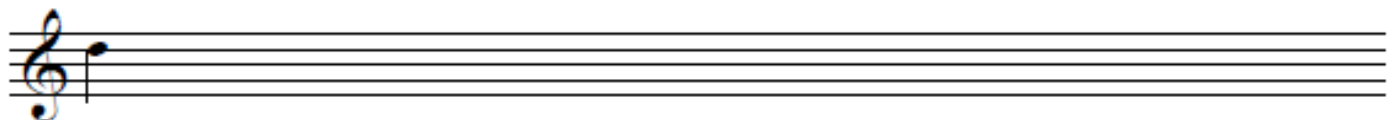
4. Draw 10 half notes on the second space, follow the rules for a whole note when drawing the circle and add a stem about the height of the staff



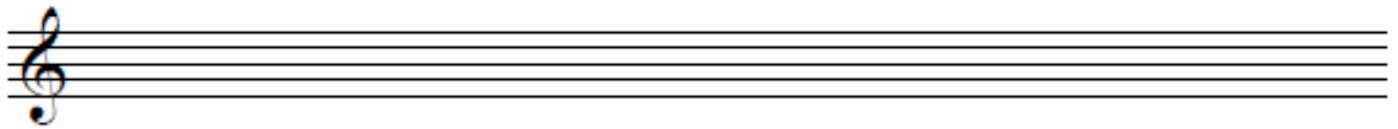
5. Draw 10 quarter notes on the third space, follow the rules for a whole note, but fill in the circle and add a stem about the height of the staff



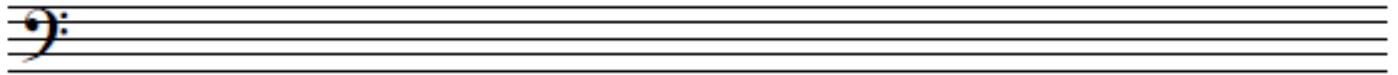
6. Draw 10 quarter notes on the fourth line, follow the rules for a whole note, but fill in the circle and add a stem about the height of the staff



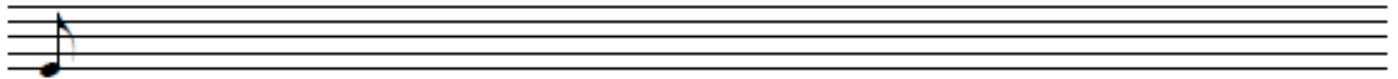
7. Draw 10 treble clefs (use the one to the left as a guide).



8. Draw 10 bass clefs (use the one to the left as a guide).



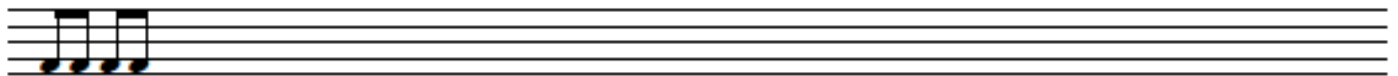
9. Draw 10 single eighth notes, use the one written as a guide, first create a quarter note, then add a flag going down



10. Draw 10 single eighth notes, use the one written as a guide, first create a quarter note, then add a flag going up



11. Draw 20 eighth notes, connect the 2 eighth notes that are next to each other, use the 4 written eighth notes as a guide



12. Copy the notes written
