# Mystery Music Grids

Instructions: Step One: Using the colors listed for each music symbol, identify and color the symbols on the Mystery Music Grid Lesson to reveal a hidden picture.

Then use your 2nd blank grid to write the symbols in the squares; one symbol for each square of that color. Fill in the colors for your key at the bottom of the page. Can you name the symbols?
