

- 1. Melody-only vocal music sung by monks to aid churches in prayer.
- 2. Originated from African-American work songs and spirituals; lyric-based and expressive.
- 3. Lyrics about love and dancing from the 1960s-70s.
- 4. Transmitted through oral tradition with a simple melody and song structure.
- 5. MCing, turntables, breakdancing, and rhythmic beatboxing are elements of this type of music.
- 6. Poetry set to classical music, usually sung by a vocalist and simple piano accompaniment, originating in Germany.
- 7. Jamaican rhythm and blues with topics of news, social gossip, and political commentary.

- 1. Group or solo singing without instrumental accompaniment
- 2. Four to seven singers also playing instruments such as the guitar, double bass, fiddle, five-string banjo, and mandolin.
- 3. Folk music from Trinidad and the Caribbean consisting of steel drums, marimbas, horns, shakers, and brassy tambourine.
- 4. Traditional music of Ireland, Scotland, and Wales using instruments such as the lute, violin, flute, and bagpipes.
- 5. Singers perform a dramatic work combining text and music in a theatrical setting. Two modes of singing




