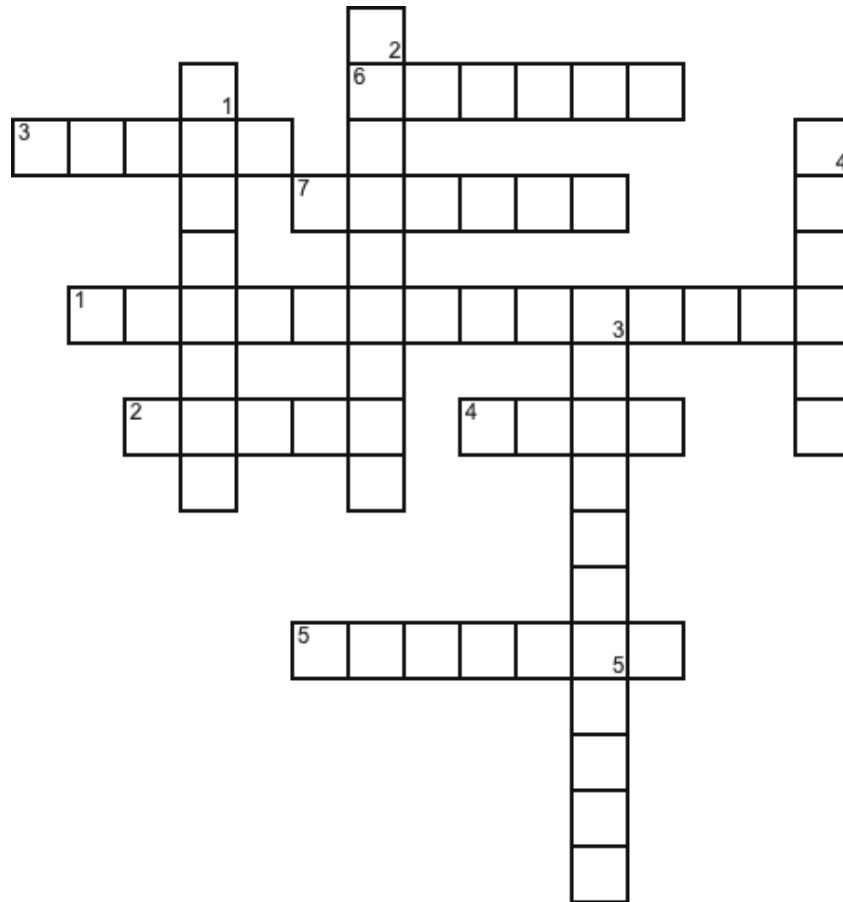

# Music Genre Madness



## Across

1. Melody-only vocal music sung by monks to aid churches in prayer.
2. Originated from African-American work songs and spirituals; lyric-based and expressive.
3. Lyrics about love and dancing from the 1960s-70s.
4. Transmitted through oral tradition with a simple melody and song structure.
5. MCing, turntables, breakdancing, and rhythmic beatboxing are elements of this type of music.
6. Poetry set to classical music, usually sung by a vocalist and simple piano accompaniment, originating in Germany.
7. Jamaican rhythm and blues with topics of news, social gossip, and political commentary.

## Down

1. Group or solo singing without instrumental accompaniment
2. Four to seven singers also playing instruments such as the guitar, double bass, fiddle, five-string banjo, and mandolin.
3. Folk music from Trinidad and the Caribbean consisting of steel drums, marimbas, horns, shakers, and brassy tambourine.
4. Traditional music of Ireland, Scotland, and Wales using instruments such as the lute, violin, flute, and bagpipes.
5. Singers perform a dramatic work combining text and music in a theatrical setting. Two modes of singing

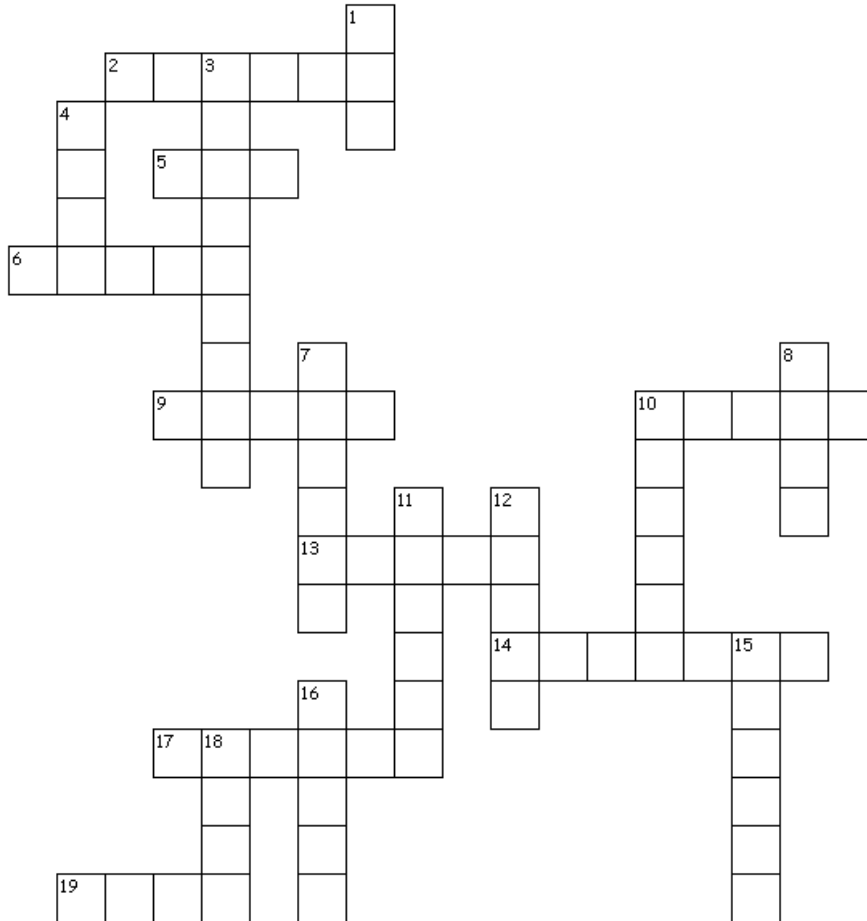
