

Music Memory Matching Game

Description: Test your knowledge of basic music symbols and their meanings with this Music Memory Matching Card Game.

Materials: paper or print at home worksheets, scissors, pen or pencil

Instructions: Copy onto paper or print Music Memory Cards

NOTE: These cards are designed to be printed two-sided. If you want a sturdy set of cards, try printing on cardstock paper. Cut out the cards and shuffle your deck.

Playing the Game:

Alone – Turn all the cards face down and set them in rows. Select two cards and turn them over. If the symbol matches the name/definition, you've made a set! If not, turn both cards back over and try again. Keep selecting cards until you have matched all the sets.

With another person(s) - Turn all the cards face down and set them in rows. The first player selects two cards and turns them over. If the symbol matches the name/definition, that player keeps the set and takes another turn. If not, turn both cards back over and the next player takes a turn. Keep selecting cards until all the sets have been matched. The player with the most sets is the winner!
