
## Kyrene Theatre Enrichments for Middle School At-Home Learning

## TITLE: Create a dialogue: Trapped in Quarantine

SHORT DESCRIPTION: Write a dialogue describing a single moment from your time away from school. This might include: carrying on a conversation whilst exercising social distancing, having someone sneeze or cough near you without covering their mouths, or carrying on a digital conversation with someone with spotty internet.

MATERIALS: Paper, pencil

OPTIONAL: Perform the dialogue with people in your house. Share video or the script of the dialogue with your teacher via Google Classroom.



INSTRUCTIONS: While pieces do no not have to be completely factual, draw from your personal experience as you create this dialogue, with at least 2 characters. The more real you can make it, the better. Be true to emotions the characters are feeling; SHOW rather than TELL how they are feeling. (I.e. Think of another way a character could communicate how they are feeling rather than saying, "I'm so mad at you!")
