Sustainability Efforts

- Goal 3 Objective A & C
- Facility Improvements
- 2005 Bond Initiative
- Excess Utilities elimination
- Reduce energy & natural resource consumption
- Use of District facilities
- Reduce the utility expenses in the M&O budget allowing additional revenues for instructional purposes

System Upgrades

- Chiller Equipment
 - 19% increase in efficiency
- Energy Management
 - 20% of use is during peak rates
 - 20% of use is during shoulder rates
 - 60% of use is during off peak hours
- Lighting
 - T-12 to T-8 systems
 - Rebates



System Upgrades

- Skylights
 - Renovations and upgrades
 - Lighting controls
- Technology Upgrades
 - Flat panel monitors
 - Sleepy
- Behavioral Changes

Total Cost Savings

- System upgrades over the past 5 years
- Surveyed 26 campuses
- Total estimated Maintenance and Operations budget savings annually:

\$500,000



Energy Star Recognition

- US Department of Energy program
- Recognizes schools in the top 25 percentile of reduced energy consumption
- Currently 26 schools in Arizona have been identified
- Kyrene has identified 11 school campuses eligible for this distinction!
